The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 4 has completed its review of Georgia's Final 2022 Clean Water Act section 303(d) List of water quality limited segments. The EPA has determined that each of the water quality limited segments still requiring total maximum daily loads, identified on the State's List, meets the requirements of the Clean Water Act section 303(d) and its implementing regulations at 40 C.F.R. section 130.7. The EPA hereby approves Georgia's decision to include each of the waters designated by the State in its 2022 303(d) List.
