Terry Johnson

Terry Johnson works at U.S. EPA's Region 4 office in the Air, Pesticides, and Toxics Management Division, where he is a member of the Clean Power Plan implementation team. Mr. Johnson has been involved in the development and implementation of EPA's Clean Power Plan since September 2013. Prior to joining EPA's Region 4 staff in 2015, he worked in the Air Programs Branch of EPA's Region 6 office in Dallas for four years. Mr. Johnson has a bachelors degree in chemical engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology. Prior to joining EPA, Mr. Johnson worked as a consultant and for Georgia EPD's Air Protection Branch for 10 years, where he was a manager in the stationary source permitting and technical support programs. He began his career in environmental protection at Delta Air Lines, where he was the manager of the corporate environmental, health and safety department for 7 years.

Bert Pearce

Bert Pearce is an environmental engineer with Georgia EPD's Air Protection Branch. He currently develops rules and state implementation plans (SIPs) to help Georgia achieve national air quality standards (particulate matter, ozone, and regional haze) and is doing groundwork for Georgia's state plan to implement the Clean Power Plan. Bert previously wrote air quality operating permits for Georgia industrial facilities. Prior to EPD, Bert worked in industrial environmental compliance and in environmental consulting. He holds a BS in Electrical Engineering from Clemson University and an MS in Environmental Engineering from Georgia Tech and is a registered professional engineer.
