## **Notice of Draft Groundwater Withdrawal Permit – IMERY'S Carbonates USA, Inc. – Cisco Mine – April 1, 2025**

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) announces its intent to issue a New Groundwater Withdrawal Permit No. 105-0002 for water withdrawal of 0.500 MGD/ 0.500 MGD (Monthly Average/Annual Average in million gallons per day) from none well(s) in the Paleozoic Rock aquifer for the purpose of mine dewatering.
