Hamilton Point/Heather Woods Subdivision Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP)

NPDES Permit No. GAJ020030

Lowndes County, Suwannee River Basin

Comment	EPD Response
The public notice states “ ... the permit has been modified to include language for an approved Sludge Management Plan to deliver sludge to a third party for further treatment and ultimate disposal.” Is the “third party” location going to be the land where the public notice signs are displayed?	The “third party” is not a location but an entity or private company. EPD is authorizing the facility to dispose of sludge generated at the wastewater treatment plant by a permitted private company. The facility has indicated on their application they will use a company called NDB Septic Tank Service, located at 512 S Davis St, Nashville, GA 31639 (or other a licensed septic tank pumping service available at the time). NDB will be required to provide final disposal of the sludge at a permitted location in accordance with all applicable federal and state regulations. EPD is not authorizing the land application of sludge at the facility
If the answer is “yes” to question above, is that waste going to be emptied into that location, via dumping, or is some sort of facility going to be built there?	See response above.
If the third party location is not the land the signs are displayed, where is the third party location?	The “third party” is not a location but a private company.
