NOTICE OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND PERSONS

Warthen Water Association has made an application to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund and the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division (EPD) for a loan through the Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund (DWSRF). The loan is for the construction of second well which is needed to ensure drinking water availability and to avoid vulnerability to a catastrophic scenario of having a fire event and a failed pump. The applicant has certified that the project is environmentally sound. As required by the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act and the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program Guidelines, an environmental review has been performed on the project described below:

Project Description

Under this project, Warthen Water Association plans to install an additional 100 gpm drinking water well to supplement their existing well.

Anticipated Impacts

The proposed project will have minimal impact on the environment as construction will be limited to the existing project site. This proposed well addition will provide increased reliability.

A review of the Preliminary Engineering Report and Environmental Information Document for the proposed project has been performed by EPD's Drinking Water Permitting and Engineering Program. A copy of these documents is available for public examination upon request at EPD between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday at the address listed below.

On July 21, 2023, Warthen Water Association conducted a public meeting in accordance with the requirements of DWSRF guidance in order to inform the public about the project. The Association received no adverse comments. The project has undergone an Executive Order 12372 Review through the State agencies. The project has also been submitted to the Corps of Engineers, State Historic Preservation Office, and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for review. No adverse comments have been received. No further environmental review of the project is proposed to be conducted prior to the release of loan funds.
