NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED REISSUANCE OF A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) GENERAL PERMIT FOR DISCHARGES FROM PHASE II SMALL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEMS (MS4S) TO THE WATERS OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA.

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is considering the reissuance of General NPDES Permit No. GAG610000 authorizing stormwater discharges from the Phase II Small municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s) to the waters of the State of Georgia. To be authorized to discharge stormwater under this permit, the permittee is required to submit a Notice of Intent (NOI). The permittee will submit a stormwater management program summarizing the best management practices to be used by the permittee to reduce pollutants to the maximum extent practicable. This NPDES Permit will be valid for a maximum of five years.
