The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is proposing to incorporate the following amendments to Georgia’s Rules for Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance, Chapter 391-3-20, into Georgia’s State Implementation Plan (SIP):

- Proposed amendments to Georgia’s Rules for Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance, Chapter 391-3-20, that will be presented to the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Board of Directors (DNR Board) for adoption at its January 16, 2019 meeting.
- Previous amendments to Georgia’s Rules for Enhanced Inspection and Maintenance, Chapter 391-3-20, that were adopted by the DNR Board on October 26, 2016 and February 28, 2018. The public comment period for these rule amendments ended on October 4, 2016 and December 22, 2017, respectively.
- Previous amendments to Georgia’s Rule 391-3-20-.06 that were adopted by the DNR Board on January 31, 2014. The public comment periods for these rule amendments ended on November 1, 2013 and January 10, 2014.
