Where is the Soperton Water Pollution Control Plant that LanzaTech will be discharging to? Will the discharge piping cross Rock Creek? Is there a map/layout of it on the net somewhere?	The City of Soperton Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP) is located at Sessions Road, Soperton, Georgia 30457 in Treutlen County, approximately 3 miles to the southeast of LanzaTech Freedom Pines Biorefinery. Based on the information provided by the City of Soperton, there are no records of sewer piping crossing Rock Creek. The discharge and associated collection system pipe from LanzaTech Freedom Pines Biorefinery is located along Commerce Drive towards West Main Street, leading to the City of Soperton's WPCP.
