On behalf of our client Colonial Terminals, Ramboll Environ US Corporation (Ramboll Environ) is providing the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) this Progress Letter Report as requested in EPD's correspondence dated November 14, 2017. The purpose of this letter is to document the activities that have been conducted since the submittal of the May 2016 Semi-Annual Status Report for the Colonial Terminals Plant #2 Site (EPD Hazardous Site Response Act [HSRA] No. 10098) located at 373 North Lathrop Avenue in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.

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**AGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DURING THIS REPORTING PERIOD
(May 31, 2016 – December 20, 2017)**

The following communications were documented since submittal of the Semi-Annual Progress Report, dated May 31, 2016:

- February 2, 2017 – On behalf of the site's responsible parties (RPs), Ramboll Environ provided responses to comments that EPD provided on February 16, 2016, regarding documents submitted during 2014 and 2015 for the site.
- February 10, 2017 – EPD provided comments to the RPs on the 2016 Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) documents.
- April 27, 2017 – EPD provided responses to the comments that the RPs submitted on six (of the seven) comments that EPD provided on February 16, 2016, regarding the documents submitted during 2014 and 2015.

- June 14, 2017 – Colonial Terminals submitted a letter to the EPD requesting a phone call to discuss EPD’s letter dated April 27, 2017, regarding the site.
- June 22, 2017 – A conference call was held between Colonial Terminals, EPD, and Ramboll Environ to discuss the site.

SITE ACTIVITIES – CURRENT PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE
(May 31, 2016 – December 20, 2017)

In accordance with the agreement with the RP’s and EPD under the VRP, no additional site work was required to be conducted. Therefore, there have been no activities conducted at the Colonial Terminals Plant #2 site since during the current period of performance.

ACTIONS SCHEDULED FOR THE NEXT REPORTING PERIOD
(December 20, 2017 – May 20, 2018)

The following action is currently planned for the next reporting period:

- Colonial Terminals will work with EPD to resolve the outstanding biological oxygen demand issue.

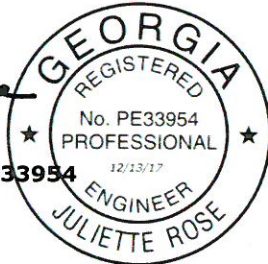
