

EPD Stakeholder Meeting Land Protection Branch Discussion of Rule Changes

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Land Protection Branch announced on June 27, 2017 that it is conducting a stakeholder meeting to discuss the proposed rule changes for the calculation of environmental cleanup standards in accordance with the Rules for Hazardous Site Response. The meeting will be held on July 10, 2017 from 1:30 to 3:30 pm in the DNR Board Room, 2 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, SE, Suite 1252 East Tower, Atlanta, Georgia 30334.

The purpose of this meeting is to inform and solicit input from the public and impacted organizations regarding the development of amendments to the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (391-3-19) related to Risk Reduction Standards (RRS) calculations.

EPD's primary goals and objectives are to ensure that stakeholders are given the opportunity to understand the process of rule revisions and the scope of the rule changes that are under consideration. EPD will also listen to comments and address stakeholder questions.
