## Notice of Public Meeting on Drinking Water Program Updates to Minimum Standards for Public Water Systems (Appendix C) and Draft Rule Amendments

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Watershed Protection Branch will hold a virtual public meeting to discuss the Drinking Water Program's updates to a guidance document and draft rule amendments. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, October 19, 2022 beginning at 10:00 am** on the Zoom web conferencing platform. The Drinking Water Program has prepared a <u>draft Appendix C to the Minimum</u>

<u>Standards for Public Water Systems</u>, "<u>Asset Management Plans for Public Water Systems</u>" for public review and comment.

The Branch has also prepared <u>draft amendments to Chapter 391-3-5</u>, <u>Rules for Safe Drinking Water</u> for public review and comment. The draft rule amendments address asset management plan requirements by adding paragraph (11) to Rule 391-3-5-.04.

Both of these items will be discussed during the public meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to inform and solicit input from the public and impacted organizations regarding these items. EPD will also listen to comments and address stakeholder questions during the meeting.
