Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to impact 40 linear feet (1,005 ft²) of stream buffer along the Apalachee River to construct an outfall structure with headwalls as part of the construction of an effluent force main associated with the expansion at the Tanners Bridge Water Pollution Control Plant. Upon completion of land-disturbance, the stream buffer will be re-established with native riparian vegetation. The project is located on Tanners Bridge Rd. off Hwy. 11 in unincorporated Barrow County.
