Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(A-K)}: B

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The City of Atlanta proposes to impact 800 linear feet (35,867 ft²) of stream buffer along two un-named tributaries to Proctor Creek to perform instream and streambank restoration measures to improve water quality and aquatic habitat quality. The streams are highly entrenched and have little hydrologic function, vegetative canopy and poor instream habitat quality. Impacts include grading to produce bends protected with toe wood and boulders, and installation of riffles and pools. Upon completion of land-disturbance the stream buffer will be re-vegetated with a canopy of native riparian species.
