NOTICE OF DRAFT PM2.5 EXCEPTIONAL EVENT DEMONSTRATIONS

To All Interested Parties:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) announces its intent to submit final *Exceptional Event Demonstrations* to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for 129 event days. Georgia EPD is required to post draft *Exceptional Event Demonstrations* for a 30-day public comment period as part of the exceptional event regulations (72 FR at 13560).

Exceptional events are unusual or naturally occurring events that can affect air quality but are not reasonably controllable. When EPA concurs with an exceptional event, that data can be excluded from the design value used for comparison to the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS).

Georgia EPD's air monitoring network consists of a number of stations located throughout the state. Georgia EPD uses air monitoring data to track attainment with air quality standards, to assist in enforcement actions, to determine air quality trends, to evaluate and approve industrial expansion, and to provide air pollution information to the public. Georgia EPD's 2021-2023 *Exceptional Event Demonstrations* will demonstrate that Georgia EPD's PM_{2.5} ambient air monitoring network was impacted by multiple exceptional events throughout the 2021-2023 timeframe.
