Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

This project will improve and install sidewalks, add curbs and gutters, relocate a driveway, and add grass stripping and a grass shoulder. Buffer intrusions are related to adding permanent pervious fill for sidewalk construction and will be mitigated with native riparian vegetation where practicable. The proposed project will result in approximately 88 linear feet (690 square feet) of buffer disturbance lasting approximately 12 months. The site is located on Callaway Road SW from the west shoulder between Al Bishop Drive and Cumberland Creek Trail SW to Woodleigh Road SW and effects an unnamed tributary to Olley Creek (Open Water 2) as well as Olley Creek in the Middle Chattahoochee Basin.
