Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

This project will consist of updating the Rock Creek Park Canoe Launch at the Etowah River by replacing wooden walls with engineered concrete foundation walls and bioengineered streambank stabilization. All areas with disturbed or exposed soils within the project limits will be replanted with a multi-trophic native riparian vegetation. The proposed project will result in 37 linear feet (1,173 square feet) of buffer disturbance lasting approximately 4 months in the Etowah Watershed (03150104).
