This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (b)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will consist of restoring the Greensferry Tributary and Proctor Creek to a more natural condition, as well as increase floodplain storage on site during peak storm events. 991 feet of concrete lining is to be removed and replaced with structural erosion control measures, including bolder stone-toe protection, constructed riffles, and grade control structures. Aging stormwater infrastructure and sanitary sewer connections will be replaced and realigned. All disturbed areas of the streambank will be rehabilitated by removing invasive species, then using bioengineering practices to stabilize the soil with Coir Fabric and revegetate the area with a variety of native riparian plants. The proposed project will result in approximately 200 linear feet (10,018.8 square feet) of buffer disturbances lasting approximately 17 weeks located at the intersection of Proctor Creek and the Greensferry Tributary in Atlanta, between Troy Street NW and Burbank Drive NW, in the Middle Chattahoochee Watershed.

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
