Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a) & (c)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

This project will consist of raising a dike for the storage of dredge material, repair of the associated gravel access road, and maintenance of a bird island habitat area in collaboration with the US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). Best management practices such as vegetation cover, stream bank stabilization, slope stabilization, silt fences, construction of terraces, interceptor channels, sediment traps, inlet and outfall protection diversion channels, and sedimentation basins will help to prevent erosion and sedimentation. The proposed project will result in approximately 223 linear feet (4,489.27 square feet) of buffer disturbance lasting approximately 10 months located at Onslow Island on the Savannah River, in the Lower Savannah Watershed.
