## Notice of Public Meeting on Draft Rule Amendments Under Consideration for Chapter 391-3-7 and Buffer Mitigation Guidance Updates

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Watershed Protection Branch will hold a virtual public meeting to discuss draft rule amendments. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, December 16, 2021 beginning at 10:00 am** on the Zoom web conferencing platform.

The draft rule amendments to be discussed are specific to **Chapter 391-3-7**, **Erosion and Sedimentation Control**. EPD is considering draft rule amendments that will ensure consistency and compliance with House Bill 577 and include other clarifying amendments to the rules. Updates to EPD's Buffer Mitigation Guidance will also be discussed.
