Notice of Public Meeting on Draft Rule Amendments Under Consideration for Chapter 391-3-7

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Watershed Protection Branch will hold a virtual public meeting to discuss draft rule amendments. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, February 17, 2021 beginning at 2:00 pm** on the Zoom web conferencing platform.

The draft rule amendments to be discussed are specific to **Chapter 391-3-7**, **Erosion and Sedimentation Control**. The goal of this meeting is to provide the public, affected organizations, and other stakeholders an opportunity to provide input and feedback on the draft rule amendments.
