I. NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT TO DISCHARGE TREATED WASTEWATER INTO WATERS OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA

NPDES permits are valid for a maximum of five years. Prior to expiration of an existing permit, a new application must be submitted and evaluated.

An antidegradation analysis is conducted, as applicable, for new or expanded point source discharges that are proposed. The analysis evaluates whether allowing lower water quality is necessary to accommodate important economic or social development in the area in which the waters are located. In all cases, existing instream water uses and the level of water quality necessary to protect the existing use is maintained and protected.

All municipalities must be in compliance with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Service Delivery Strategy in order to receive a permit.

Having reviewed such applications, the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is considering the issuance of NPDES permits to the following applicants, subject to specific pollutant limitations and special conditions.

Notice of Application for the Land Treatment System Permit to Apply Treated Wastewater to a Land Application Site in the State of Georgia

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received a new application for the reissuance of an existing LAS permit. Having reviewed such application, EPD proposes to issue for a maximum term of five years the following permit subject to specific pollutant limitations and special conditions:

Fieldale Farms Corporation, Post Office Box 558, Baldwin, GA 30511, Permit No. GAJ010369 for a commercial waste treatment facility located at 270 By-Product Drive, Eastanollee, Georgia in Stephens County. Approximately 0.25 MGD of pretreated poultry by-product rendering waste will be land applied to a site in the Savannah River Basin.

EPD will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on January 17, 2019. The hearing will be held at the Old Historic Courthouse Courtroom, located at 37 West Tugalo Street Toccoa, GA 30577. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive comments on the draft LAS permit for Fieldale Farms Corporation.

The public hearing is a formal process to receive comments on the draft permit. Participants who wish to comment for the record are requested to sign in upon arrival. Hearing participants will not be subject to questions from the audience, but may be questioned by the Hearing Officer for clarification of technical points or to develop a better understanding of statements. Questions asked by participants making statements will be answered by EPD in writing at a later date. Lengthy statements or statements of a considerable technical or economic nature should be submitted in writing for the official record. During the hearing, oral statements shall be limited to three (3) minutes to allow everyone an opportunity to be heard. Comments should be confined to water quality issues.

Written comments are welcomed. To ensure their consideration, written comments should be received by close of business on **January 21, 2019**.
