## **Notice of Draft Groundwater Withdrawal Permit – Bryan County Board of Commissioners – July 19, 2018**

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) announces its intent to issue Modified Groundwater Withdrawal Permit No. 015-0007 for water withdrawal of 1.600 MGD/ 1.600 MGD (Monthly Average/Annual Average in million gallons per day) from eight wells in the Upper Floridan aquifer for the purpose of a central water supply, per EPD's previous commitment outlined in special condition #13 of the current withdrawal permit (Genesis Point Transfer). The existing 2020 & 2025 coastal permit limit reductions and schedule contained within the current withdrawal permit will remain unchanged.
