The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) announces its intent to issue a Modified Surface Water Withdrawal Permit to the Etowah Water and Sewer Authority (Permit No. **042-1415-01**) for water withdrawal of **6.9 MGD/6.0 MGD/4.3 MGD** (Max Day/Monthly Average/Annual Average in million gallons per day) from the Etowah River in the Coosa River Basin for the purpose of municipal water supply.
