Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to the authority set forth below, the Environmental Protection Division (hereinafter, "EPD") of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources proposes amendments to the Rules for Erosion and Sedimentation Control, Chapter 391-3-7. EPD proposes amendments to the Rules for Erosion and Sedimentation Control that will ensure consistency and compliance with House Bill (HB) 577, include other clarifying amendments to the rules, and include reference to the updated "Buffer Mitigation Guidance."

The proposed rule amendments are proposed for adoption pursuant to authority contained in the Erosion and Sedimentation Act of 1975, O.C.G.A. § 12-7-1 et seq.
