Notice of Stakeholder Meeting for initiation of a Statewide Comprehensive Nutrient Permitting Strategy

June 2022

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Watershed Protection Branch will hold a virtual meeting to inform stakeholders about EPD's intent to develop a statewide Comprehensive Nutrient Permitting Strategy (CNPS) for point source wastewater dischargers.

This meeting will provide an overview of the draft Nutrient Roadmap for the development and implementation of a Comprehensive Nutrient Permitting Strategy to reduce nutrient pollution from point source discharges into waters of the State.
