Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to impact 390 linear feet (7,314 ft²) of stream buffer along an impoundment to Perry Creek to breach the failing dam and outlet control structure. The pond will be drained, the dam breached by excavating and removing the existing pipe, placing the excavated material into the dry pond bed, grading the area, and revegetating the buffer of the stream to restore the stream back to pre-existing conditions. The project is located off Jimmie Mayfield Blvd.
