Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The applicant proposes to impact 3,987 linear feet (267,894 ft<sup>2</sup>) of stream buffer along Kelly Mill Branch and four unnamed tributaries to perform stream restoration measures using natural channel design principles. Portions of the channels will be realigned, and construction of in-stream structures consisting of cross vanes, log j-hook, and riffles and pools will aid in providing a stable plan, pattern and profile for the streams. Upon completion of land-disturbance, the stream buffer will be re-planted with a canopy of native riparian species. The overall intent of the project site is to enhance the development of the proposed Cumming City Center.
