Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The Fort Benning Golf Course - Armory Creek Dam is located along on an unnamed tributary to Upatoi Creek / Armory Creek near Marne Road in Chattahoochee County. This project will consist of installing a new 12" Ø PVC siphon system and concrete weir auxiliary emergency spillway, re-grading the existing dam to create a stilling basin downstream of the siphon system and auxiliary emergency spillway and removing the existing asphalt golf course path, bridge and abutments and installing a new asphalt golf course path and truss-type bridge over the auxiliary emergency spillway. All disturbed areas will be restored to current conditions to the extent practicable. The proposed project will result in approximately 605 linear feet total (8,458 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along the Fort Benning Golf Course lake and an unnamed stream, tributaries to Upatoi Creek / Armory Creek in the Middle Chattahoochee – Lake Harding Watershed.
