Activity

This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Site plans are available for review and are located in the following EPD office: Watershed Protection Branch, 200 Piedmont Avenue SW, Suite 418 West, Atlanta, GA 30334. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Storm events have caused severe streambank erosion and sedimentation along an unnamed perennial stream on a residential property along Hendon Road in Cherokee County. The proposed project will consist of grading the streambank to a more stable slope (2H:1V) and soil bioengineering practices (including live staking with *Black Willow*, *Swamp Haw*, *Arrowwood* and *Silky Dogwood* cuttings and *Lamp Rush* grass). The proposed streambank stabilization project will result in 316 linear feet total (4,942 square feet total) of buffer impacts along an unnamed perennial stream, a tributary to Mill Creek in the *Etowah Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
