This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Site plans are immediately available for review and are located in the following EPD office: Watershed Protection Branch, 200 Piedmont Avenue SW, Suite 418 West, Atlanta, GA 30334. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.11 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The Clayton County Water Authority (CCWA) is modifying the *existing* W. B. Casey Water Reclamation Facility to include a *new* effluent polishing facility. The construction of the effluent polishing facility (including the discharge pipe and outfall structure) will impact approximately 81 linear feet of the buffer along the Flint River in Clayton County. All disturbed areas will be restored to current existing conditions to the extent practicable. This project will result in buffer impacts (including riprap and streambank stabilization measures) to approximately 81 linear feet (2,005 square feet) along the Flint River in the *Upper Flint Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
