Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (d)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will consist of replacing the *existing* 24" Ø reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) gravity sewer lines with approximately 6,330 linear feet of 30" Ø ductile iron pipe (DIP) gravity sewer lines along North Goddard Road and Arabia Mountain Path in DeKalb County. All *existing* manholes will be replaced with *new* 5' Ø precast manholes. All disturbed areas will be returned to original grade and stabilized with mulching and permanent vegetation and all open-cut trenches will be backfilled and restored to current conditions to the extent practicable. The proposed project will result in approximately 1,089 linear feet total (12,450 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along Stephenson Creek in the *Upper Ocmulgee Watershed*.

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
