This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.11 (2)(a-k)}: (f)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will consist of constructing a walking trail (including ±165 linear feet of boardwalk) and a floating dock/viewing area along an *existing* pond (4.7 acres) in Pinewood Forrest, a mixed-used development along Veterans Parkway in Fayetteville. The proposed walking trail will be designed to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and constructed using *permeable* mixed slate/stone aggregate with an edge treatment. Mitigation for the permanent buffer impacts will consist of planting native riparian, multi-trophic vegetation along the proposed trail. This project will result buffer impacts to approximately 1,046 linear feet (10,225 square feet) along an unnamed pond, a tributary to Sandy Creek in the *Upper Flint Watershed*.
