Wills Park – Regenerative Stormwater Conveyance (RSC) System
Activity

This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Site plans are immediately available for review and are located in the following EPD office: Watershed Protection Branch, 200 Piedmont Avenue SW, Suite 418 West, Atlanta, GA 30334. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.11 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

As outlined in the *Foe Killer Creek Watershed Improvement Plan*, the City of Alpharetta is proposing to construct a Regenerative Stormwater Conveyance (RSC) System along an *existing* stormwater gully (i.e., ephemeral drainage feature) to address stormwater runoff from an *existing* paved parking lot and the adjacent swimming facilities and baseball fields in Wills Park in Alpharetta. The proposed RSC system will restore the incised and eroded stormwater gully (approximately 200 linear feet) with a series of shallow pools, cascades, riffles, weirs and outfalls providing stormwater energy dissipation, temporary ponding and infiltration (including TSS pollutant removal). The proposed project will result in buffer impacts to approximately 40 linear feet (1,000 square feet) along an unnamed perennial stream, a tributary to Foe Killer Creek in the *Upper Chattahoochee Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
