Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The City of Atlanta, as per a Court Order issued *In Rem* in April 2017, is proposing to demolish a vacant apartment complex and the associated infrastructure and restore the buffer to existing residential conditions (i.e., bermuda and/or fescue grasses) along an unnamed tributary to Proctor Creek at 1600 Carlisle Street in Atlanta. This project will result in 450 linear feet (26,136 square feet) of buffer disturbances along an unnamed tributary to Proctor Creek in the *Middle Chattahoochee – Lake Harding Watershed*.
