Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(a-k)}: <u>a & b</u>

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed streambank stabilization and restoration project involves buffer encroachments necessary to restore and enhance eroding streambanks and improve stormwater quality leaving the site. The eroding streambanks will be graded and stabilized with grade stabilization structures, live stakes and coir logs. Additional buffer disturbance activities include construction of swales for floodwater control, replacement of a failing retaining wall with natural rock and buffer revegetation. The buffers will be revegetated with native multi-trophic riparian vegetation, and the constructed swales will be vegetated with native herbaceous seed mix and plugs. This project will result in 1,120 linear feet (26,584 square feet) of buffer impacts along the Chattahoochee River in the *Upper Chattahoochee* River Basin.

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
