This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a), (d) and (e)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed single-family residential development will be located along McEver Road in Flowery Branch. The proposed project will consist of upgrading the *existing* gravel roadway across the dam to comply with the City of Flowery Branch Code of Ordinances and installing water, sewer and utility lines along the roadway. Construction activities will include re-grading the *existing* earthen dam and installing a *new* principal spillway (72" Ø RCP with headwall and riprap apron) and *new* 6" Ø PVC toe drains. The buffer will be restored to current conditions to the extent practicable. The proposed project will result in 238 linear feet total (18,730 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along an unnamed lake, a tributary to Lake Lanier in the *Upper Chattahoochee Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
