Description and Location of Proposed Activity: <u>The proposed project would impact Perennial Stream (PS)</u> 5, PS 7, Intermittent Stream (IS) 10, PS 12, and IS 14 outside of any exemption areas for the widening of <u>State Route (SR) 219 and the construction of passing lanes at three locations. The project would impact</u> <u>the 25-foot state mandated buffer of unnamed tributaries to Mulberry Creek and Schley Creek within</u> <u>the Middle Chattahoochee-Lake Harding watershed. The proposed project consists of an approximately</u> <u>5.13-mile long corridor and begins approximately 10 miles north of the City of Columbus, GA. The total</u> <u>length of the proposed passing lanes is approximately 3.52 miles with 3.07 miles in Harris County and</u> <u>0.45 miles in Muscogee County.</u>
