This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an Application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(A-K)}: A & H

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Applicant proposes to impact a total of 405 linear feet (16,968 ft²) of an unnamed tributary to Bull Creek that includes 119 linear feet (5,078 ft²) of stream buffer and 286 linear feet (11,890 ft²) of stream and buffer to conduct intersection improvements by constructing a new roundabout at the intersection of Ft. Benning and Cusseta Rd. Two existing buildings inside the 25-foot buffer will be demolished under criteria "A" impacting 119 linear feet (5,078 ft²); under criteria "H" the unnamed tributary will be relocated and the old channel filled, impacting 286 linear feet (11,890 ft²) of stream and buffer. This is the 2nd revision of a public advisory to correctly reflect the appropriate amount of impact for the project.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
