Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Stormwater runoff has caused severe streambank erosion and loss of property along Parkway Drive in Tifton. The proposed project will consist of grading the streambanks to a more stable slope and integrated bio-engineering practices (including vegetated rock gabions with *Eastern Cottonwood* live stake cuttings and *Flexamat*[®] with *Switchgrass*). *Flexamat*[®] consists of concrete blocks embedded into a flexible, high strength geogrid with spacing for site specific vegetation. The proposed streambank stabilization project will result in 1,080 linear feet total (11,506 square feet total) of buffer impacts along unnamed tributaries to the Little River in the *Little Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
