Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will consist of *abandoning-in-place* the existing gravity sanitary sewer lines (exhibiting structural collapses and deformations) and installing approximately 802 linear feet of 8" Ø and 10" Ø PVC gravity sanitary sewer lines and *new* manholes along Bell Creek near Avenue N in the Cotton Mills neighborhood in Thomaston. All disturbed areas will be returned to original grade and stabilized with mulching and permanent vegetation and all open-cut trenches will be backfilled and restored to current conditions to extent practicable. The proposed project will result in 800 linear feet total (13,540 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along Bell Creek in the *Upper Flint Watershed*.
