Description and Location of Proposed Activity: <u>The proposed project would impact the 25-foot vegetative</u> <u>buffer of Open Water 13 (OW-13) for the widening and relocation of State Route (SR) 15 in Washington</u> <u>County. The proposed project will consist of four travel lanes, two in each direction and separated by a</u> <u>24-foot raised median. The project would impact the 25-foot state mandated of OW-13 which drains to</u> <u>an unnamed tributary of Sisters Church Creek. The proposed project begins at SR 242 to the south, and</u> <u>continuing along the new location until it ends at SR 15.</u>
