Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2) (a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity: The proposed project would impact Intermittent Stream 1 (IS1) for the median opening improvements on State Route (SR) 300/U.S. Highway (US) 19 from Dougherty County to Warwick, Georgia. The buffer of IS1 will be impacted due to the need for a right turn lane along SR 300 (northbound) at Camp Osborn Road. The right turn lane would improve safety and orderly progression of traffic through the corridor. The project would impact the 25-foot Statemandated buffer under criterion 2(a) within the Middle Flint watershed.
