This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Site plans are immediately available for review and are located in the following EPD office: Watershed Protection Branch, 200 Piedmont Avenue SW, Suite 418 West, Atlanta, GA 30334. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 50-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.11 (2)(a-k)}: (d)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project involves replacing approximately 2,993 linear feet of *existing* gravity sewer lines and installing approximately 263 linear feet of *new* gravity lines with 15" Ø PVC SDR-26 pipe and 16" Ø ductile iron pipe (DIP) complete with appurtenances along an unnamed tributary to the Tallapoosa River east of the Arbacoochee Road pump station in Tallapoosa. All disturbed areas will be returned to original grades and stabilized with mulching and permanent vegetation and all open-cut trenches will be backfilled and restored to current existing conditions to the extent practicable. This project will result in 1,384 linear feet total (38,139 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along an unnamed tributary to the Tallapoosa River in the *Upper Tallapoosa Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
