Persons in Georgia who sell new replacement tires or who generate scrap tires, must complete and submit this form to Georgia EPD per the Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act, O.C.G.A. 12-8-20, as amended. By signing this document, the applicant agrees to comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules, and regulations. **Items marked with an asterisk (\*) are required.** Incomplete applications will be returned. Scrap tires must be collected and transported by an EPD-permitted tire carrier (see [epd.georgia.gov/scrap-tires](http://epd.georgia.gov/scrap-tires) for current list). Companies may transport their own tires to a processor or end user, or for disposal, provided they have appropriate documentation. Tire retailers can also transport their own used tires, with appropriate documentation.
