Dear Ms. Lloyd:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) received and reviewed your Sixth Semi-Annual VRP Progress Report dated January 31, 2016 and Seventh Semi-Annual VRP Progress Report dated August 1, 2016 for Former Rose City Cleaners Site. EPD provides the following comments:

- 1. EPD would prefer to keep deep well DW-1 in place at this time. EPD understands that a risk of cross-contamination of aquifers exists when installing a deep well, but cross-contamination can usually be avoided when following proper well installation procedures. Although it should remain as an active well, DW-1 may be removed from the semiannual sampling itinerary. Please note that when DW-1 is sampled for final certification to risk reduction standards, Teflon tubing must be used.
- 2. In Appendix C of the Seventh VRP Semiannual Progress Report, PCE analytical data from June 2016 is not included on the concentration trend graphs for MW-3 (Figure C.2), MW-5 (Figure C.3), MW-6 (Figure C.4, and MW-7 (Figure C.5). Please ensure that concentration trend graphs in future reports are updated and current.
- 3. EPD concurs with your proposed actions such as ERD-ZVI Injections, Monitoring Well Sampling, and Contaminant Source Assessment outlined in the Section 4.0 of the Seventh VRP Semiannual Progress Report. Once more data are obtained from the area adjacent to or underneath the bank building, vapor intrusion should be reevaluated with the latest data to demonstrate that there would be no unacceptable health impact on the people working inside the bank building at the site.
