RE: Drought Response Variance Approval -- Drought Response Level Two


Dear Mr. Adams:

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 12-5-7 and GA Rule 391-3-30-.08, the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the City of Senoia's (Senoia) request for a variance from the current State Drought Response Level 1 to a Drought Response Level 2 in order to implement more stringent restrictions.

EPD understands that the Coweta County Water & Sewerage Authority (Authority) provides water to Senoia, and EPD is aware of the water supply challenges the Authority is currently experiencing. EPD recently granted a variance request to the Authority for a Drought Response Level 2, valid until December 31, 2019, with the provision for an extension if conditions have not improved 10 days prior to the expiration of the Authority's variance.

Therefore, based on this information and in consideration of the ongoing climatic and water supply conditions occurring within your area, EPD has determined that good cause has been shown to support your request. EPD hereby approves a variance for the City of Senoia to implement Drought Response Level 2 measures in the applicable service areas, as provided in EPD rule 391-3-30.07(4). As you requested, this approval is valid until the Coweta County Water & Sewerage Authority's variance for a Drought Response Level 2 is no longer in effect.
