RE: Work Practice and LDAR Plans Approval


Dear Ms. Hartman:

On February 1, 2022, the Division received the Work Practice Plan for the Sterigenics Atlanta facility. Since this plan had been previously updated and approved as specified in November 2021, the same WPP was submitted to satisfy the requirements of Permit Condition 5.8 of newly issued Air Quality Permit No. 7389-067-0096-S-06-0. The EPD concurs that the submittal satisfies that requirement.

On March 7, 2022, the Division received the initial Leak Detection and Repair (LDAR) plan for the Sterigenics Atlanta facility. The LDAR plan is required by Permit Condition 5.9 to monitor all outside components for leaks at least weekly. The submittal also provided further details of the monitoring program such as training, recordkeeping, and reporting. The submittal received satisfies the requirement of Permit Condition 5.9 and is hereby approved. Please implement the LDAR plan within 60 days of receipt of this approval.
