In accordance with the provisions of the Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act, and the Rules promulgated pursuant thereto, this permit is issued for the following operation:

Wilkinson County – McIntyre Landfill #3, a private industrial landfill located at 1277 Dedrick Rd. McIntyre, Georgia (Latitude: 32.85036, Longitude -83.2274).

This permit is conditioned upon the permittee complying with the attached conditions of operation, which are hereby made a part of this permit.

All statements in the application and supporting evidence, information, and data submitted to the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources have been evaluated, considered and relied upon in the issuance of this permit.

This permit is now in effect; however, under Georgia law it is subject to appeal for 30 days following issuance and is subject to modification or revocation on evidence of noncompliance: (i) with any provision of the Act or of the Rules promulgated pursuant thereto; or (ii) with any representation made in the above mentioned application or the statements and supporting data entered therein or attached thereto; or (iii) with any condition of this permit.

Conditions for Private Industry Solid Waste Landfill

1. Only industrial waste from KaMin LLC shall be deposited at this private industry solid waste disposal facility.
2. No hazardous or putrescible waste shall be deposited at the landfill.
3. All waste shall be spread in layers and compacted to the least practical volume.
4. A uniform compacted layer of clean earth cover not less than one (1) foot in depth shall be placed over all exposed waste materials at least monthly or more frequently as may be determined by the Division.
5. The final cover shall consist of clean earth cover not less than (2) feet in depth over the final lift of waste not later than one month following placement of waste within that lift.
6. Erosion and sedimentation control devices shall be installed and maintained to control all surface runoff and sediments from disturbed areas.
7. A vegetative cover must be established during the placement of the final cover to minimize erosion.
8. The landfill shall be operated in such a manner as to prevent air, land, or water pollution, and public health hazards and nuisance.
9. Access to the landfill shall be limited to authorized entrances which shall be closed when the facility is not in operation.
10. A minimum 200 foot buffer shall be provided between the property boundary and the waste disposal boundary.
11. All-weather access roads shall be provided to the facility and provisions shall be made for prompt equipment repair or replacement when needed.
12. This permit shall become null and void one year from the effective date if the permit disposal operation has not commenced within one year from the effective date.
13. The Design and Operational Plan submitted by the permittee and approved by the Division for this private industry solid waste landfill is hereby made a part of this permit and the private industry solid waste landfill shall be operated in accordance with the plan.
14. Closure plans, post-closure plans and appropriate financial responsibility shall be maintained and updated as provided for in the approved Design and Operational Plan.
