RE: PM_{2.5} Exceptional Event Demonstrations

Dear Ms. Diaz:

With this letter, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is submitting final PM_{2.5} Exceptional Event Demonstrations to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for 104 event days. Georgia EPD's 2022-2024 Exceptional Event Demonstrations show that Georgia EPD's PM_{2.5} ambient air monitoring network was impacted by multiple exceptional events throughout the 2022-2024 timeframe.

The following final PM_{2.5} Exceptional Event Demonstrations are being submitted:

The public notice for the draft Exceptional Event Demonstrations was published August 4, 2025, on GovDelivery.com and the Georgia EPD Air Protection website. The draft Exceptional Event Demonstrations were also posted on the Georgia EPD Air Protection website for review on August 4, 2025. The public comment period ended on September 4, 2025. Written comments were received. A summary of the comments and EPD's responses are included as part of the submittal.
