This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 50-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Posey Lake Dam, a High Hazard Category I Dam, is located on Shoemaker Branch (upstream of Patterson Creek and Betty Creek) along Tarheel Lane in Rabun County. The existing High Hazard Category I Dam is not in compliance with the *Georgia Safe Dams Act*. Therefore, this project will consist of reconstructing the existing earthen dam (i.e., lowering the dam height to 22.0 feet and reducing the maximum dam storage to 23.45 acre-feet) and installing a new principal spillway (4 - 16" Ø PVC siphons) with a riprap plunge pool and an auxiliary spillway (50-ft wide open cut channel). All disturbed areas will be stabilized with permanent vegetation. The proposed project will result in approximately 545 linear feet total (30,660 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along Posey Lake and Shoemaker Branch in the *Upper Little Tennessee Watershed* in Rabun County.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
